## Top 3 expectations for Go ENG Girl!:

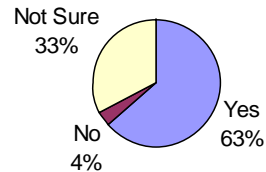
1. Learn more about engineering (75%)
